RECIPE CORNER

APPLE BREAD

Great for the holidays

Preheat oven to 350 degrees.

Soften **1 cup butter or margarine** in an oven-proof dish in the oven while the oven is preheating. Cream together with **1 cup sugar** in a large mixing bowl.

Dissolve **1 tsp. baking soda** in **1 T. fresh lemon juice**.

Combine **baking soda mixture, 2 eggs, and 2 tsp. vanilla with butter mixture**. Beat mixture together.

Add **2 cups flour** and **1/4 tsp. salt**. Mix to combine but do not over mix.

Peel, core, and slice **2 or 3 medium apples** (organic preferred) and coarsely chop apple slices. Gently fold apples into butter mixture.

Crumb Mixture:

Combine **1 tsp. cinnamon, 2 T. sugar, and 2 T. flour** in dish you used to melt butter in the oven and cut in **2 T. cold butter or margarine** to get a coarse crumb texture.

Spoon 1/2 the batter mix into a greased loaf pan. Sprinkle with 1/2 crumb mixture. Spoon in remaining batter and sprinkle with remaining crumb mix. Press crumbs gently into surface of batter. Bake for approximately 1 hour 15 minutes or until toothpick inserted in center comes out clean.

Cool 10 minutes in the pan then remove bread and cool thoroughly on a non-stick cooling rack before slicing and serving it.

Yields approximately 16 slices from 1 loaf.
