Celebrating its first anniversary, the Mukilteo Community Garden welcomed back the Mukilteo Kiwanis on the 1st Saturday in April. This day marked International Kiwanis One Day, where globally Kiwanis Clubs volunteer a day of service in their community.

What a difference a year makes! Last year Kiwanis helped break ground at the garden by pulling weeds and cleaning out blackberry bushes. This year members joined other volunteers in erecting a new greenhouse. The donation of the greenhouse enables the garden to grow vegetable starts on a year round basis and will help to make our food bank gardens extremely productive.

More than 1500 square feet of beds are dedicated to the Mukilteo Food Bank and are supported by a grant from the South Everett/Mukilteo Rotary Club. This grant also has enabled electrical power to be brought to the garden.

Kudos to Tony McNulty's Papa Murphy's for donating the pizza and fellow members Tim Taylor and associate Pam Campbell for servicing lunches to the volunteers.
