## HAPPY BIRTHDAY KIWANIS

1914: Allen S. Browne, a professional organizer for fraternal groups, has an idea for a new kind of club and begins recruiting business and professional men in Detroit (Motown). Browne's proposed name for the group, the Benevolent Order Of Brothers, is rejected. As one member said, "Who wants to belong to an organization called BOOB?"

A committee consulted a local historian who tells them about a phrase in the local American Indian language: Nunc Keewanis, which means (approx.) 'we get together' or 'we trade'...(Ed. Note: Does it sound a lot like a '**potlatch**' in Suquamish, or Haida...or Snoqualmie languages???) The Motown club adopted an abbreviated version of this **Nunc Keewanis**. January 21, 1915, is the official birthday of KIWANIS.
