2008 Lieutenant Governor's Project

Char Peiffer is the 2007-2008 Lieutenant Governor for Division 21. She has selected "Kids in Cars" as her project.

"Kids In Cars" focuses on helping to eliminate injuries and deaths caused by leaving children unattended in or around cars. "Kids in Cars" is working with Legislators in several states to raise the level of awareness regarding children being left alone inside vehicles. They maintain a national database documenting injuries and deaths of children left unattended in or around vehicles.

From July 1, 2000 – June 30, 2001 an estimated 9,160 children age 14 and younger were treated in US Hospital emergency rooms for injuries caused by being left unattended in or around motor vehicles.
