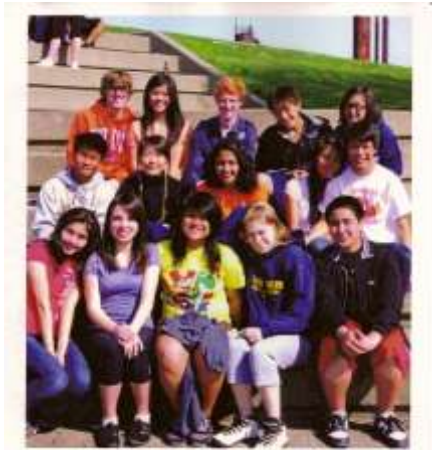
## KEY CLUB ACTIVITIES
