Kiwanis to provide 7000 Volunteers to create Rose Parade Floats

INDIANAPOLIS - The Kiwanis International Rose Float Committee is providing 7,000 volunteers - the largest pool of volunteers from any organization - to create 10 floats for the 2010 Rose Parade.

The volunteers come from all over North America and represent nearly all of Kiwanis International's clubs: Builders Club, for middle school students; Key Club for high school students; Circle K International for college students; Aktion Club for adults with disabilities and Kiwanis for adults.

"Service is at the heart of every Kiwanis club," said Kiwanis International President Paul Palazzolo, who will ride on the Kiwanis International float with his family. "Our 7,000 volunteers will help make this year's Rose Parade an artistic success."

Kiwanis volunteers have already worked the first three Saturdays in December. Beginning December 26, Kiwanis volunteers will work one of two decorating shifts each day through December 31. Five hundred volunteers will work each shift, and Kiwanis clubs will feed the volunteers lunch and dinner. Kiwanis volunteers will work a total of 56,000 volunteer hours to complete the floats.
