VOLUNTEERING???



Each month we ask members to report on their volunteer activities, broken down into two areas; Kiwanis hours and non Kiwanis service hours.

The Kiwanis hours, excluding normal meeting times, covers fund raising, projects, and other hours expended on Kiwanis related business. The non-Kiwanis service hours is for service for the community, churches, and other non profit organizations, etc.

Using the last 12 months data, we find that our members have contributed around +1,000 hours to Kiwanis related activities and around 430 hours to non Kiwanis service areas. (Note: These are conservative numbers as some members do not report their hours.)

With regards to Kiwanis hours, 28 active members have volunteered their time...as with most organizations, the hours/member contributed vary widely as shown below:

00 - 12 hours:	8 members
13 - 25 hours:	9 members
26 - 40 hours:	4 members
41 - 100 hours:	4 members
100 hours +:	3 members

For the non Kiwanis hours, 9 members have contributed:

10 - 40 hours:	6 members
41 - 100 hours:	2 members
100+ hours:	1 member

BOTTOM LINE: Based \$22.50/hr, the amount national non-profits use to value their volunteer hours....our annual Kiwanis hours are valued at \$22,500, and those members that served outside of Kiwanis...your contribution is valued at \$9,675.


