Your Kiwanis Club of Edmonds Charitable Foundation recently met and , after reviewing written requests, is providing funding totaling \$1,050+ to the following organizations:

Washington "Kids in Transition": (\$500)

To help stock their emergency food pantry, \$500 will be sent to KIT. This organization is focused on assisting the 450+ homeless students in the Edmonds school district.

Cedar Valley Community School: (\$300)

To help restock their emergency food pantry, \$300 will be sent to the Edmonds School District for distribution of funds to CV. This school has in excess of 80% of their students on free or reduced cost meals.

College Place Elementary School: (\$???)

We currently have \$100 in designated funds for the CP emergency food pantry. In addition, we anticipate added donations (cash and food) from our members 9/29. These funds will be sent to the Edmonds School District for distribution to CP. This school has over 75% of their students on free or reduced cost meals.

Reading with Rover Program: (\$250)

This unique reading program, featured at one of our club meetings, will receive \$250 to help students who are struggling with reading and speaking skills.
