Dictionaries help students spell success

“Look it up.” The familiar phrase sends students racing through the pages of a dictionary to discover a new word. Kiwanians in **Greensboro, North Carolina**, want to make sure all North Carolina third-graders have access to a dictionary.

“Third grade is when a dictionary is a part of the curriculum,” explains Kiwanian Doug Stewart. “Our long-term goal is to put a dictionary in the hands of every precious third-grader in the state—every year.”

He admits this is no small feat, but with help from the **Kiwanis clubs of Nat Greene, Gate City, and High Point**, third-graders at each of Guilford County’s 63 elementary schools received dictionaries this past year.

“We began targeting those schools that had the greatest number of free lunches,” Doug says.

Bringing the lofty goal to an attainable level, the three Greensboro clubs work with **The Dictionary Project**, a nonprofit organization that provides the resources for a bargain \$1 per dictionary.

“We know it’s a big elephant,” Doug says. “We’re starting with tiny bites at a time.”
