THRIVE/YCPO team up for flu season

The Kiwanis Young Children: Priority One (YCPO) program will team up with Tackling the Health Risk of Influenza through Vaccinations and Education (THRIVE) for the 2005-06 flu season.

Each year almost 20 percent of the US population is infected with the flu, a number which Kiwanis and THRIVE are attempting to reduce. Kiwanis clubs in the US should expect to get a pamphlet in the mail of educational materials about influenza and a tool kit in late July that will contain everything they need to carry out the program so THRIVE and YCPO can further knowledge about how influenza effects everyone and who is getting vaccinated

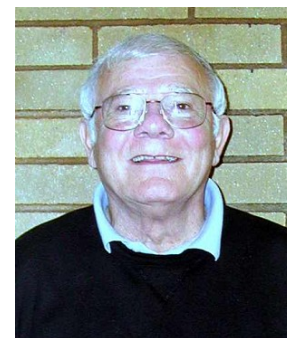
